Dear Sir/Madam,

I would like to bring your kind notice on the interim order of the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand. The Hon'ble court, in Writ Petition (PIL) No. 164 of 2013 has observed that the institutions under the HNB Garhwal University are permitting admissions more than their permitted intake; mandatory minimum 180 days of teaching a year do not followed and the teachers are not available in the institutions for five hours a day. As per directions of the Hon'ble High Court, the University has submitted affidavit that from 2014-15 academic session the University will implement the orders of the Court and actions like de-affiliation, debarring students from appearing examinations and action against HOD/Principal treating it as contempt of the Court.

The matter was also placed before admission committee for the academic session 2014-15 of the University. The committee resolved that:

1. Every institutions affiliated to the University shall have to specify the Course, Duration and Sanctioned Strength (approved seats) in their admission prospectus from the academic session 2014-15 onwards, and submit a copy of their prospectus to the Registrar of the University before completion of their Admission. Failing which the University will initiate actions like de-affiliation and debarring the students of their institution from examinations.
2. In any case, any admission beyond the approved sanctioned seats will be the responsibilities of the Principal of the institutions in case of affiliated colleges and HOD, Director of the campuses and Deans of the concerned Schools as the case may be, in case of campuses of the University.
3. HODs will be held responsible for non implementation of minimum teaching of 180 days in a year.
4. Principals/HODs/ Campus Directors and Deans of the Schools as the case may be, will ensure that the faculty members are available in the college/Departments for a minimum of 5 hours a day.

As the above directions are made in compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand, the above persons will be held responsible in case of contempt for non implementation in true spirit.

In view of above, I am requesting you to abide the direction of the Hon'ble Court and resolution of admission committee in true spirit.
