Prof. S.C Bagri (President) formally inaugurated the webinar and apprised about the HNBGU Alumni Association. He shared the journey of the rejuvenation of the association and its core strengths. He further mentioned that the theme “Alumni Connect” encapsulated the confluence of all the renowned invitees who have their roots in HNB Garhwal University.

During his address, Prof. Bagri stressed the importance of alumni contributing to the upliftment of their Alma Mater by extending professional support through campus placement, vocational training and other means.

Prof. Annapurna Nautiyal (VC) appreciated the whole concept of the webinar and congratulated the entire team for making the virtual meet possible. She discussed how the University Administration is like a stem that plays an integral part in ensuring a sound educational ecosystem.

Students need mentoring support for choosing the right career path and a combination of technology and human intervention in channelling talents and placing them in the right spot, added the Vice-Chancellor. She also thanked President, Prof. SC Bagri and Secretary, Mr Mahipal Singh Rawat for organising the webinar on such short notice. The forum appreciated the efforts of the VC in this regard.

The Vice-Chancellor also highlighted the importance of strengthening the Alumni Association, which was agreed upon by all. She cited an example of IIT Alumni Association Endowment Funds, which are building a corpus for the welfare of the students and their Alma Mater.

Shri Kalyan Singh Rawat Padma Shri, a retired teacher who sowed the seeds of the Maiti Movement from Gwaldadam, Chamoli has pioneered a unique environmental initiative aimed at environment protection through afforestation. Shri Rawat talked about the relationship between teachers and their students and how his students approached him even after he retired and sought his advice when they needed it.

His emphasis was on the friendly relationship with nature that forms the basis of our lives. During his last remarks, he stated that if every student of the university became sensitive and aware of the environment, there would be fewer complications.

Shri Mantri Prasad Naithani reminisced about the good old days at Garhwal University. The skills he had gained from attending university have always been a benefit to him. In his remarks, he touched upon a variety of topics.

Prof. Anoop Dobriyal suggested setting up a chair in Prof. H.R. Singh's name. Prof. Dobriyal noted that the concept of the Alumni Association evolved for needs from both the ends- academicians and professionals, with the aim of building a bridge between college life and career.

Prof. R.C Ramola focused his views on bringing foreign nationals to the university. In his words, the aforementioned factors can help us build our brand as a destination of choice for foreigners.

Prof. Seema Dhawan enlivened the event by quoting from the books of late former President Abdul Kalam.

The webinar concluded with a vote of thanks by the Shri Mahipal Singh Rawat (Secretary), who recalled the journey of the Alumni Association. Mr Rawat discussed with the members and speakers the various activities initiated to raise awareness of the various topics of importance to the Alumni Association. Following are a few points that he touched on:
