Frequently Asked Questions

Q. 1. Fees of B. Tech. course

Answer: Fees for first year is **Rs. 17,160** (Including 5000 caution money) for first semester. If candidates have already paid more than this amount through JOSAA/CSAB, fees will be adjusted accordingly. For full course fee structure please visit the university website and refer the admission brochure.

Q. 2. Regarding hostel accommodation

Answer: Hostel allotment is at University level. We have sufficient hostel for Girls students. However, for Boys, University has limited number of available seats, so hostel accommodation is not guaranteed to all students. Students need to fill Hostel forms and an allotment will be done at university level. This process might take 1 to 2 months so students are advised to arrange accommodation/ lodging themselves for initial period. For further clarification, please contact Chief Warden Office, contact no. of which is available on University main website. Private Paying Guest accommodations are easily available near the university campus.

Q. 3. Regarding hostel fees

Answer: Residential charges around 3000 to 4000 per year and mess charges around 3200/month depends on the hostel allotted and usage.

Q. 4. Regarding placement cell

Answer: School has a placement cell in place, which helps students to be placed in various companies.

Q. 5. Regarding refund (In case student doesn't want to take admission in the university)

Answer: If student doesn't report/complete admission formalities he/she need to take refund from CSAB directly. If student has taken admission in university and want to withdraw, university will refund fees only after receiving the fees from JOSAA/CSAB. University will deduct the non-refundable charges of university as per rule.
