# Corrigendum Notice for Offline/ Physical Reporting/ Counseling

It is informed that Offline/ Physical Reporting/ Counseling, based on CUET (UG) score - 2023, for admissions in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of B. Tech. (Instrumentation Engineering (IE), Information Technology (IT), Mechanical Engineering (ME), Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), and Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE)) programs in this university, for the session 2023-24, is scheduled to be held on  $1^{st}/2^{nd}$  September, 2023, to fill up the vacant seats in General, EWS, OBC, SC and ST category.

The Offline/ Physical Reporting/ Counseling will be held as per the following schedule (Table-1):-

Candidates, who have *received the email through SAMARTH Portal* for attending the Offline Reporting/ Counseling and meet CUET (UG)-2023 score criteria given in Table-2 below, must ensure their presence **in person**, at Swami Manmathan Auditorium (University Auditorium), Chauras, H.N.B. Garhwal University Srinagar (Garhwal) for reporting and counseling as per the given date and time in Table-1 above. **In case, such candidates do not appear for offline reporting/ counseling, their candidature for admission to B. Tech. programs will be cancelled.**

Candidates meeting the criteria in Table-2 should note the following:

- Candidates, who have been allotted a seat in B. Tech. program of their highest priority (in 1<sup>st</sup>/ 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list), and have completed physical document verification after depositing the fee by due date and time, do not need to participate in the offline Reporting/ Counseling.
- Candidates, who have been allotted a seat (in 1<sup>st</sup>/ 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list) in any B. Tech. program other than their highest priority, and have completed physical document verification after depositing the fee by due date and time, must participate in the offline Reporting/ Counseling on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2023, so that they may be allotted a seat in B. Tech. program of higher priority that they have already applied.
- Candidates, who have not been allotted a seat (neither in 1<sup>st</sup> nor 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list) in any B. Tech. program, may participate in the scheduled offline Reporting/ Counseling on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2023.

Candidates not meeting the criteria in Table-2 shall note that their applications may be considered for subsequent rounds of seat allotment against the vacant seats, if any, after the scheduled offline Reporting/ Counseling on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2023.

### The following documents must be produced at the time of Reporting/ Counseling:

- Printed application form, filled by candidate through the SAMARTH portal.
- One set of self-attested photocopies of Aadhaar ID, Class 10<sup>th</sup> Certificate/ Mark sheet, Class 12<sup>th</sup> mark sheet, CUET (UG) 2023 Score Card, Certificate (if applicable) of OBC-NCL/ SC/ ST/ EWS/ Ex-Service Man/ PwD category/ sub-category, NCC/ NSS certificate, etc., and all other relevant documents. OBC-NCL (in the format of Central Government) and EWS Certificates must be issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023.
- Original Transfer Certificate (TC) or Migration Certificate, Character Certificate (CC), Affidavit for the gap year period (if applicable), and Anti-Ragging Affidavit (as given in the University Prospectus 2023–24).
- Five (05) passport size photographs.

The counseling shall be strictly based on the normalized score (NTA Score) of CUET (UG)-2023 entrance test. If offered admission, the candidate has to take admission by 5:00 p.m. on 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2023, by filling up a prescribed Admission Form and by depositing tuition and other fees, failing which the allotted seat to him/her will be treated as cancelled. The candidates note that this letter is only for offline Reporting/ Counseling, and it does not give any guarantee for admission. The admission will be subjected to the availability of the seats in the respective categories and fulfilment of the eligibility criteria.

The tuition fee of the B. Tech course is Rs. 22000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Thousand only) per year, the campus/college fee is Rs. 980/- (Rupees Nine Hundred Eighty only) per year and Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) onetime as caution money (refundable) i.e., **Total of Rs. 27980/- only**. Candidates are advised to be prepared accordingly for timely deposition of fee.

Note that the university has a limited hostel facility, and the university does not provide Hostel Accommodation to all the students admitted to above mentioned programs. To avail the hostel facility, the admitted students will have to apply separately. If hostel seat is allotted, the students have to pay the fee and other charges of the hostel separately in addition to the fee of Rs. 27980/- stated above. In view of the present weather/ road conditions of the region, the candidates are advised to arrive one day before the reporting date.

Subject to the availability of vacant seats after the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023, additional rounds of seat allotment may be scheduled and notified separately.
