





Student Skill Training Program on 'Quality Control Chemist-Microbiology'

A 3-months Student Skill Training Program on 'Quality Control Chemist-Microbiology' was organized between December 2021 and March 2022 in the Department of Biotechnology, HNB Garhwal University. The training was conducted under the Skill Vigyan Program sanctioned to the University with Prof. G.K. Joshi as Program Coordinator, by Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Govt. of India and Uttarakhand Council of Science and Technology (UCOST). A total number of 18 participants with graduate degree in biological or related sciences underwent this training. Each trainee received a studentship of Rs. 5000 pm during the training. During the training, various internal and external subject experts as well as industry professionals from India as well as abroad have interacted with trainees and shared their knowledge and skills. In addition, prolonged hands on/practical training has been provided to the trainees in the domain area. On Job Training was also given to the trainees under the actual work environment in industries to gain required expertise and skills. The certification of this course was done by Life Sciences Sector Skill Development Council (LSSSDC). After having completed the training, many of the trainees got placement in industries and academic sectors.

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Journey of Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence (DACE),

H.N.B. Garhwal University

Dr. Ambedkar Foundation (DAF) is an Autonomous body under ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India. DAF launched a scheme to establish Dr. Ambedkar Centre for Excellence (DACE) in 31 Central Universities, one from every State/UT of India. Through the Scheme, the Centre shall empower Scheduled Caste students in competitive exams by providing the best and free coaching facilities. The scheme was launched on 22nd April 2022 at Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi in the presence of the Hon'ble Governor, Uttar Pradesh, Smt. Anandiben Patel and Chairman Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, Dr. Virendra Kumar (Minister of Social Justice & Empowerment). Two other Ministers of State for Social Justice & Empowerment Shri. A. Narayanaswamy & Km. Partima Bhuomik was also present. The MoU was signed by the 24 Central Universities on 22 April 2022 including H.N.B. Gahrwal University. Prof. R. C. Bhatt (Pro- Vice Chancellor), Dr. Ajay Kumar Khanduri(then Registrar) and Dr. Sanjay Dhyani (Deputy Registrar) represented the University during the launch of the scheme. Prof. R. C. Bhatt (Pro-Vice Chancellor) signed the MoU on behalf of university.



After signing the MoU with Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Annapurna Nautiyal appointed Prof. M.M. Semwal as a Programme Coordinator on 20 May 2022. Further, on the recommendation of Prof. M.M. Semwal, Program Coordinator, 11 member working committee (including Prof. Seema Dhawan as Deputy Coordinator) is constituted for the smooth functioning of DACE, H.N.B. Garhwal University. The working committee played an important role in advertising the DACE, conducting entrance examination, admission, inauguration of the centre and conducting the classes before the joining of full time DACE faculties. The committee also provides suggestions and feedback to the coordinator about the activities and functioning of the centre.

Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence (DACE), H.N.B. Garhwal University was inaugurated by Prof. Annpurna Nautiyal, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of H.N.B. Garhwal University and Shri Praveen Thapliyal, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Retd.) on 01-10-2022. Shri Praveen Thapliyal graced the inaugural ceremony as a Chief Guest. Prof. R.C. Bhatt, Prof-Vice Chancellor, HNBGU graced the occasion as special guest. Deans of various schools, HOD of different departments and faculty members of the university along with non-teaching staff and students were present. Regular classes at the centre were started from 10th Oct. 2022. Prof. M.M. Semwal, Program Coordinator, welcomed the students and introduced them about UPSC-CSE syllabus and preparation strategies. Initially, the classes at the centre were conducted with the help of university faculties till the full-time faculties of Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence (DACE) joined. From 3rd Oct 2022 to 09th Nov. 2022, classes were conducted with the help of university faculties for which the weekly schedule was shared with the concerned faculties and students in advance.



Online applications were invited from the eligible candidates for 03 full time faculty positions at DACE and interviews for the selection of faculties were conducted on 29th Oct. 2022. The result of the interview was declared on 3rd Nov. 2022. Mr. Prakash Kumar Singh, Dr. Ashish Bahuguna, and Dr. Bharat Kumar Rajak were selected for the faculty positions. After joining of full time DACE faculties (7th Nov. 2022 onwards) new class schedule was designed and classes are being conducted as per time table since then. Teaching and learning process at the DACE is being conducted from 10.00 AM to 4.30 PM. In addition, DACE also invites faculties from other departments of the University for the Guest Lectures on various areas of the UPSC CSE syllabus based on the requirement. Before the CSE 2023 preliminary examination on 28 May 2023, a

total number of 590+ classes have been conducted at DACE since the beginning of DACE classes on 10th October 2022.



The progress of the students is evaluated periodically by various measures. The various methods are carried out by the centre to evaluate the performance of the students. MCQ based mock tests are conducted (for CSE prelims) to evaluate the progress of the students. This helps students to learn the topics with better understanding keeping UPSC pattern in mind. Till CSE prelims 2023, centre has conducted fourteen Mock tests (i.e. 8 full length + 6 sectional) to evaluate the progress. Answer writing practice is also conducted periodically (for CSE mains preparation) at the centre to prepare students for the mains examination. Answer writing helps students to understand the patterns of Mains exam and the depth and analytical nature of questions being asked in the previous year papers. Moreover, feedback from the students is received after each class by the concerned faculty and periodically by the coordinator. Moreover, an online questionnaire was also shared with students to get their feedback periodically. Before the UPSC-CSE prelim, a series of full length Mock Test was organized by DACE for boosting confidence of the students and analyzing their preparation/progress. The full length test series comprises of 8 mock tests in the last three weeks of preparation before preliminary examination. Moreover, two full length Mock Tests were made open to all the civil services aspirants from the different departments of the university to compare the progress of DACE students with other CSE 2023 aspirants.



In addition to regular classes, various other activities were also conducted by DACE for the overall personality development of CSE aspirants. Following activities were conducted as follows. To bring environmental awareness among students, a talk on climate change was organized by the DACE. Prof. S.P. Sati, an eminent environmentalist and researcher was invited to deliver a keynote lecture on the climate change and its consequences. The talk also covered the impact of climate change on Himalaya/Himalayan region. Similarly, to boost the confidence of students for the UPSC-CSE preparation, a motivational lecture was organized by DACE. Prof. D.S. Negi, a motivational speaker and former Dean School of Sciences, H.N.B. Garhwal University was invited to deliver a talk. Prof. Negi interacted with the students and motivated students by one to one discussion. Moreover, a workshop on "Nasha Mukti" (i.e. De-addiction) was also organized by DACE to increase awareness of students about the impact of addiction on the society. At the end of workshop a pledge was also taken by all the participants not to indulge in any kind of addiction and also spread public awareness about the consequences of addiction. UPSC-CSE preparation and guidance session was organized by DACE by inviting Prof. S.P. Kala, former Professor of Management and an ex-civil servant with 15+ years beaurocratic experience. Prof. Kala shared various strategies for the UPSC-CSE preparation with students and motivated them to remain positive throughout the duration of preparation. On 14th April 2023, Ambedkar Jayanti was celebrated to commemorate Dr. Bhimarao Ambedkar and his contribution to the nation and society. The program was organized in collaboration with SC &ST Cell of the H.N.B. Garhwal University.



DACE, invited Mr. Hemant Sati (IAS 2016, Jharkhand Cadre) to interact with students. The online interaction was attended by more than 120 students from various departments of the university along with DACE students. Mr. Sati interacted with students and congratulated them for their motivation to prepare for civil services. He gave multiple suggestions and unique strategies to prepare and ways to avoids mistakes during preparation.
