#### Resolution

Prof. Shivani Sharma apprised the Executive Council about the representation received regarding agenda item number 22.6 of the Academic Council, which is about the BoS recommendations of Dept. of Tourism (CMTHS).

The main point of concern was the recommendations made by BoS, at Agenda point No. 2 in its meeting on 31.05.2024 regarding eligibility /qualifications for teaching posts of Hotel Management. As per directions of Chair Person Executive Council / Hon'ble Vice Chancellor all the records / BOS proceedings register were called upon for perusal of the Executive Council Members. It is observed that recruitment process on sanctioned /vacant teaching posts of the Hotel Management could not be initiated due to decision regarding screening the application as per UGC regulation or AICTE regulation. It is further observed that the Hotel Management program being offered by the Dept. of Tourism (CMTHS) is not accredited/approved by the AICTE. And no departmental documentation was available regarding initiation of AICTE accreditation. After detailed deliberation, the Executive Council directed that BoS proceedings dated 31.05.2024 of the Dept. of Tourism (CMTHS), under agenda item No. 22.6 of the academic council. The resolution of agenda item no. 2 of the BoS of Dept. of Tourism (CMTHS), which covers the recruitment qualifications of the teaching posts of Hotel Management program, may be kept in abeyance. The Executive Council directed to send the matter for reconsideration of academic council. Also, the former and present HOD Tourism (CMTHS) shall be directed to submit a report to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor regarding efforts made by them with documentary proof regarding accreditation /approval of the AICTE for Hotel Management program.

Rest of the recommendations made by the Academic Council in its 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting including the draft ordinances of PVC were ratified/approved by the Executive Council.

- 2. The Executive Council was apprised that after completion of the interviews on the Non-Teaching Group A posts (Director UR-01, Deputy Director UR-01, Assistant Director UR-01) of the Center for Folk Performing Arts and Culture, a section of students raised some queries and objections regarding reservation roster on subject posts, therefore, to address their concerns an internal committee with all the Deans and external subject expert was constituted by the university administration but the committee is also not able to organize its meeting due to their protest. Their point of protest is that it should not be examined by the internal serving members of the University. The Executive Council deliberated on this agenda item in detail and also commented that it is not an issue related to the students but as this is hampering the normalcy and recruitment process therefore resolved to constitute a three-member committee comprising of the following members to examine the roster and submit its report in a time bound manner. The Executive Council in its 22nd meeting dated 30-05-2023 under agenda 22.23 resolved to approve a one-time provision for such students enrolled between Academic Session 2015-16 (from the introduction of CBCS system) to Academic Session 2021-22 (till the introduction of NEP) to complete their degree and allowed such students to reappear in one paper (Theory or Practical) of any Semester of his program of study organized by the university (Minutes of the EC attached).

Various groups of students are agitated and continuously demanding that there are still many students enrolled under CBCS system who could not complete their degree programs to date and hence shall be provided one last opportunity to appear in examinations to clear 3 to 4 papers after exhausting earlier options available to pass/complete the UG/PG degree programs under CBCS system.

Therefore, in the interest of the future of students, it is proposed to provide one last chance/opportunity to such bonafide students enrolled under CBCS Examination system/pattern to appear in the 'Special Back Paper Examination' on payment of Rs. 3000/- per paper examination fee.

#### Resolution:

The Executive Council approved the above agenda as a final chance to the students under CBCS, not to be repeated or taken as precedent in future.
