इसी क्रम में माननीय केंद्रीय मंत्री, भारत सरकार, युवा कार्यक्रम एवं खेल मंत्रालय द्वारा माय भारत (My Bharat) के माध्यम से विकसित भारत यूथ पार्लियामेंट 2025 के अंतर्गत जिला स्तरीय कार्यक्रम आयोजन हेतु आपके विश्वविद्यालय/संस्थान को चयनित किया गया है।

# कार्यक्रम की रूप रेखा:-

- 1. युवा संसद कार्यक्रम में प्रतिभागिता करने हेतु प्रतिभागी की आयु 18 से 25 वर्ष (दिनांक 24 फरवरी, 2025 तक) के मध्य होनी चाहिए।
- 2. विषय : प्राथमिक स्तर (पंजीकरण के समय) "आपके लिए विकसित भारत का क्या मतलब है" प्रथम चरण में उक्त विषय पर प्रतिभागी को माय भारत पोर्टल के माध्यम से 01 मिनट का वीडियो अपलोड करना है। जनपद स्तर (भौतिक रूप में) : एक राष्ट्र, एक चुनाव: विकसित भारत का मार्ग प्रशस्त करना 03 मिनट बोलने का मौका दिया जायेगा।
- 3. उक्त विषय पर युवाओं द्वारा अपलोड की गई वीडियो का विश्वविद्यालय/संस्था स्तर पर स्क्रीनिंग (Screening) करते हुए प्रत्येक जिले से मेरिट के आधार पर चयनित युवा (यदि एक नोडल केंद्र पर एक जिला है तो 150 प्रविष्टि, दो जिले हैं तो 75 प्रविष्टि और यदि तीन जिले हैं तो 50 प्रविष्टि प्रत्येक जिले की दर से अधिकतम 150 प्रतिभागी) जिला युवा संसद में प्रतिभागिता करेंगे।
- 4. निर्धारित निर्णायक मंडल द्वारा विश्वविद्यालय/महाविद्यालय स्तर पर आयोजित युवा संसद में प्रतिभाग करने वाले समस्त जिलों में से कुल 10 उत्कृष्ट वक्ताओं (समस्त प्रतिभागी जिलों को समान अवसर प्रदान करते हुए) का चयन मेरिट के आधार पर किया जायेगा, जो कि राज्य स्तरीय युवा संसद में प्रतिभागिता करेंगे। मेरिट व अंक देने हेतु मानक संलग्न है।
- 5. प्रतिभागी युवा हिंदी अथवा अंग्रेजी में से किसी एक भाषा में निर्धारित विषय पर अपने विचार रख सकेंगे।


















# **How to Apply**

# **Detailed Steps to apply for the event:**

- 1. Open any web browser and navigate to the MY Bharat portal: https://mybharat.gov.in/
- 2. Click on "Mega Event," present in the Upper right-hand side of the page.




3. On the Mega Event page, Click on "Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament"



- 4. In **About** section, scroll down for more details and **Click on the Link** to locate your district Nodal as per your district of residence
- 5. Scroll down more and click on **View More** to specially select your district nodal to apply



6. If you are unable to manually locate your nodal district, you can use this search box to identify specific event for your node that has been created.



# 7. Click on **Apply** Button



- 8. A sign in page will pop up **Sign in I**f you are not registered on MY Bharat portal or **Login** if you are registered on portal by filling your credentials. To Sign in Click on Sign in and sign in to your account with the registered mobile number or email id.
- 9. Complete your Youth Profile with filling basic info of yours
- 10. Click on MY Bharat Logo on the Upper left hand you will enter the main page of MY Bharat portal

- 12. After clicking on apply, scroll down, and upload your 1 min video for screening to qualify for district level on the topic: "What does Viksit Bharat mean to you?"


Note - Video Submission Requirements:

- The uploaded video must have a white background to ensure clarity.
- The participant's voice must be clear and audible without background noise.
- The Video should start with Introduction in a format: [Participant's Name]- [Your District]- [State] [Nodal district] (e.g., My name is Lakshay Chhikara, I am from Sonipat, Haryana. My nodal district is Panipat).
- The maximum file size for the video should not exceed 25MB.
- The file name of the uploaded video must follow the format: [Participant's Name] [Your District] [State] [Nodal district] (e.g., Lakshay-Sonipat- Panipat -Haryana).
- The format of the video should only be: mp4, .mkv, .mov, .mpeg, .avi, .wmv, .flv
- A maximum of 150 participants will be shortlisted for the district nodal round.



## I. INTRODUCTION

The National Youth Parliament Festival (NYPF) has been organised annually since 2019 to provide a platform for young voices in India. The first edition in 2019 saw participation from 700 delegates representing each district, with 56 finalists at the national level. The second NYPF (2020-21) was conducted virtually due to the pandemic, engaging over 2.34 lakh youth from 698 districts, culminating in 84 state awardees participating in the national event at the Central Hall of Parliament. The third edition (2021-22) saw increased participation, with 2.44 lakh youth from 748 districts, 45,350 competing at the district level, and 87 state awardees reaching the national stage. The fourth NYPF (2022-23) involved 2.01 lakh participants from 763 districts, with 7,140 competing at the district level and 85 finalists at the national event. Each edition concluded with the top three winners sharing their thoughts at the Central Hall of Parliament, followed by an interactive session and address to the youth.

This year, the National Youth Parliament Festival has been reimagined as the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament, aligning with the vision of Viksit Bharat@2047. The Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament embodies the vision articulated by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji in 2017, when he called for the emergence of one lakh young leaders to take the country forward. His vision was rooted in the belief that India's youth are not just the beneficiaries of development but also the architects of its future. Inspired by this clarion call, this year's Youth Parliament has been reimagined and expanded, aligning with the Viksit Bharat@2047 vision to prepare a new generation of dynamic, solution-oriented, and policy-aware youth leaders.

This transformation reflects a more structured approach to youth engagement in policymaking, governance, and national discourse. Unlike previous editions, all rounds will be conducted offline, ensuring a more immersive and impactful experience. With a multi-tiered structure spanning district, state, and national levels, the event aims to provide young voices with a formal platform to deliberate on pressing national issues, interact with policymakers, and contribute meaningfully to India's developmental journey.

The Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament also marks a shift in the events at the national round, where unlike the previous editions when only the state champions had an opportunity to share their ideas, each participant qualifying from the state rounds will have a golden chance to speak during the opening and closing remarks and the moderated caucuses. This ensures greater inclusivity and provides a fair and open forum for a diverse range of opinions to be heard and debated. Beyond this, the national round will culminate in the drafting of a final resolution, synthesising the most insightful, pragmatic, and forward-looking ideas presented by the finalists. This resolution will be formally presented before prominent media houses, bringing youth-driven policy recommendations to the national spotlight.

#### II. OBJECTIVES OF ORGANISING THE VIKSIT BHARAT YOUTH PARLIAMENT

- A. To hear the voice of youth between 18-25 years of age, through deliberations at District, State and National levels.
- B. To encourage the youth to engage with public issues, understand the common man's point of view, form their opinions and express them in an articulate manner.
- C. To develop and enhance decision-making abilities.
- D. To develop in them respect and tolerance for the views of others.
- E. To develop in them an understanding that respect for rules is essential for conducting any discussion systematically and effectively.
- F. To obtain and document their opinions on the Vision of Viksit Bharat.
- G. To make available their views to policymakers and implementers to take it forward.

## III. CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION

- A. Youth to participate in Youth Parliament must be between 18 to 25 years of age as of 24<sup>th</sup> February 2025. The onus will be on the participant to furnish correct information in this regard. Furnishing false information will lead to disqualification from participation in the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament.
- B. The representation of women and others from marginalized sections should be encouraged.

- B. **District Level:** One Nation, One Election: Paving the Way for Viksit Bharat
- C. **State Level:** 75 Years of the Indian Constitution: A Journey of Rights, Duties, and Progress; The 11 Sankalp of Samvidhan Divas: A Pledge to Strengthen India's Constitutional Values
- D. **National Level:** One Nation, One Election: Simplifying Democracy, Amplifying Progress, Ensuring Stability

# V. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The evaluation criteria for the selection of the speakers at the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament is mentioned in the table below:

**Tie-Breaker Rule:** In case two or more candidates score same points in any particular round, a spontaneous question relevant to the topic will be asked for a quick, adept and relevant response which will be evaluated out of 10 points.

#### VI. FORMAT

The Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025 will be held in three stages in physical mode: Registration will be done via MY Bharat portal. A maximum of **150 participants** will be shortlisted for the district nodal round. The topic for the 1-minute video to be uploaded for registration will be: 'What does Viksit Bharat mean to you?'

- A. **District Nodal Round-** This round will be held at 300 nodal districts. From each district node, **10 participants** will qualify for their respective state's championship round. Each participant will be given three minutes to speak on the topics and will be assessed on the matrix as specified in section VI. The speech can be multilingual (English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu). At the district level, the institution nodal partner along with the help of MY Bharat official will shortlist maximum of 150 Participants.
- B. **State Round-** The youth selected from the district round will partake in the state round. The top 3 will be selected to represent the state in the National Round.
- C. **National Round-** Top finalists from the state level will be invited for the finale of the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament in New Delhi. Unlike previous editions where only state winners participated, all selected candidates will engage in parliamentary deliberations through different sessions. The event will facilitate interaction with policymakers, mentors, and national leaders, broadening participants' perspectives.

#### VII. TIMELINE

- a. 27<sup>th</sup> February 9<sup>th</sup> March 2025: Registrations on MY Bharat Portal
- b.  $10^{th}$  March  $-17^{th}$  March 2025: District nodal rounds to be organized in 300 specified Nodal Districts to cover all Districts in India
- c. 17<sup>th</sup> March 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025: Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament State Round
- d. 28<sup>th</sup> March 30<sup>th</sup> March 2025: Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament National Round at Delhi

# VIII. LANGUAGE

To ensure that all sections of the youth population are able to participate, the language for participation at District and State Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament will be Hindi, English, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu.

# IX. JURY

The composition of jury at different levels of the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament is as follows:

# For 1 min registration Video:

• Screening Committee (To be initiated by the institution nodal partner with assistance of MY Bharat officials)

## At District round:

- Academicians with expertise in public policy, political science, or governance.
- Senior bureaucrats or policymakers (retired or serving).
- Prominent youth leaders or social entrepreneurs.
- MLAs/ State Ministers

## At State round:

- Hon'ble Speaker/ Hon'ble Governor
- State Secretary of Sports & Youth Affairs
- State Ministers, MLA, MLA

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### 1. What is the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament?

The Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament is a platform that allows young minds to engage in national discussions and share their vision for *Viksit Bharat@2047*. It fosters leadership, civic participation, and policy discourse.

# 2. What is the format of the speeches?

Each participant gets 3 minutes to speak on a predetermined topic that will be shared with the participants once the rounds commence.

# 3. How is the Youth Parliament structured?

It consists of three stages:

District Level

State Level: Hosted at state assembly venues National Level: Finale at the Parliament of India

# 4. How many participants qualify for the next rounds?

The top 10 from each district move to the State Level. The top 3 from each state move to the National Level.

# 5. How can I register for the event?

Registration is mandatory and must be done via MY Bharat portal. # Purpose

The **Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament** embodies the vision articulated by **Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi** in 2017, when he called for the emergence of one lakh young leaders to take India forward. This year's Youth Parliament has been reimagined and expanded, aligning with the Viksit Bharat@2047 vision to prepare a new generation of dynamic, solution-oriented, and policy-aware youth leaders. all rounds will be conducted offline, ensuring a more immersive and impactful experience. With a multi-tiered structure spanning district, state, and national levels, the event aims to provide young voices with a formal platform to deliberate on pressing national issues, interact with policymakers, and contribute meaningfully to India's developmental journey.

The Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament also marks a shift in the events at the **national round**, where unlike the previous editions when only the state champions had an opportunity to share their ideas, each participant qualifying from the state rounds will have a **golden chance to speak** during the opening and closing remarks and the moderated caucuses. This ensures greater inclusivity and provides a fair and open forum for a diverse range of opinions to be heard and debated. Beyond this, the national round will culminate in the drafting of a final resolution, synthesising the most insightful, pragmatic, and forward-looking ideas presented by the finalists. This resolution will be formally presented before prominent media houses, bringing youth-driven policy recommendations to the national spotlight.

#### Scope

This SOP applies to all **participating colleges/universities** responsible for conducting the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025 at the **district level** and ensuring smooth coordination with the Department **of Youth Affairs**.

## Roles and Responsibilities

## Role of the College/University

- Serve as a **District Nodal Institution** and coordinate event execution.
- Mobilize participation from **students and non-students** in the district and nearby areas.
- Allocate **faculty members** for event organization and management.
- Provide necessary **logistics**, including venue, meals and accommodation (if required).
- Ensure **timely reporting** of event data and outcomes to DoYA.

## Role of the Department of Youth Affairs (DoYA)

- Nominate officials to **monitor and support** program implementation.
- Provide **funding** to the institution for event execution.
- Facilitate publicity through the MY Bharat Portal and social media.
- Offer guidance and training for smooth execution.

#### **Pre-Event Preparations**

# For Government Knowledge Institutions:

- An Agreement letter must be sent to DoYA.

# For Non - Government Knowledge Institutions:

An MoU letter must be sent to DoYA.

# **Publicity & Outreach:**

- Promote the event in colleges, community spaces, and social media.
- Encourage registrations on the MY Bharat Portal.

## **Screening & Selection:**

- Make meeting arrangements for the Screening Committee.
- Shortlist **150 participants** for the next round ensuring equitable distribution across nodal and associated districts. Out of these **10 participants** are to be selected for state round.
- Nominate a dedicated event coordinator from the university.
- Assign faculty and staff for logistics, outreach, and technical support.

# **Venue Arrangements**

- Reserve an auditorium/conference hall with seating capacity as per expected participation.
- Ensure availability of AV systems, microphones, projectors, and internet connectivity.
- Arrange for required amenities such as restrooms, drinking water, and emergency medical support.
- Organize transportation and accommodation for jury members.
- Ensure food and refreshment arrangements.

# **Publicity & Outreach**

- Promote the event across the university, affiliated institutions, and the district via banners, standees, and digital platforms.
- Share event details through MY Bharat portal, university website, and social media handles.
- Collaborate with local media for press releases and coverage.

#### **Registration & Screening**

- Invite applications from students and non-students (ages 18-25) through MY Bharat portal.
- Shortlist participants based on video submissions and profile evaluation.
- Publish the list of shortlisted participants at least 3 days before the event.

# **Event Execution** (District Level Round)

#### **Opening Ceremony**

- Welcome dignitaries, jury members, and participants.
- Brief participants on event structure.

## **Competition Rounds**

- Conduct multiple sessions based on the number of participants.
- Assign a panel of five jury members to evaluate speeches based on content, clarity, communication skills, innovation, and adherence to time limits.
- Select the top 10 participants for the final round.

# **Technical & Logistical Support**

- Ensure uninterrupted power supply, sound system, and live streaming if required.
- Facilitate travel and accommodation arrangements for jury members.
- Provide food and refreshments to all participants, jury, and officials.

# **Result Compilation & Submission**

- Document jury decisions using the prescribed format.
- Forward **final results** to DoYA.

## Post-Event Reporting & Financial Compliance

- Submit the following to DoYA
- **Detailed event report** with high-resolution photographs.
- Participant assessment sheets & attendance records.
- Feedback forms from jury members and attendees.
- Final financial statement and Utilization Certificate.

#### **Financial Settlement**

- Institutions that received 30%-40% advance funding must submit a final expenditure report for reimbursement.
- Unutilized funds (if any) must be **refunded within 7 days**.

#### **Communication Protocol**

- Maintain official correspondence via email and formal letters.
- Schedule periodic review meetings with DoYA officials.
- Update event progress on MY Bharat Portal.

# **Compliance & Conflict Resolution**

- Ensure financial and operational transparency in fund utilization.
- Address disputes through **DoYA-nominated arbitration procedures**.

## **Termination & Amendments**

- The MoU is valid for **one year**, extendable upon mutual agreement.
- Either party may terminate the agreement with **one-month prior notice**.
