Notice for Offline/ Physical Reporting/Counseling on 12th and 13th August, 2025 at Department of Computer Science & Engineering, Chauras Campus, H.N.B. Garhwal University.

It is to inform that Offline/ Physical Reporting/ Counseling, based on CUET (UG) score - 2025, for admissions in the 1st semester of B. Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), Instrumentation Engineering (IE), Information Technology (IT), and Mechanical Engineering (ME)) programme in the university, for the session 2025-26, is scheduled to be held **on 12th and 13th August, 2025**, to fill up the seats in UR, EWS, OBC, SC and ST categories.

The Offline/ Physical Reporting/ Counseling will be held as per the following schedule (Table-1):-

Candidates are required to attend the Offline Reporting/ Counseling CUET (UG)-2025 on the basis of CUET score criteria as given in Table-2 below. They must ensure their presence in person, at Department of Computer Science & Engineering, Chauras Campus, H.N.B. Garhwal University Srinagar (Garhwal) for reporting and counseling as per the given date and time in Table-1 above. Failure to appear for counseling will result in the cancellation of your candidature for B. Tech. admission in subsequent counseling. All candidates are advised to carefully check their CUET (UG)-2025 score, eligibility and adhere strictly to the reporting schedule provided.

Please note that seat shall be allotted as per cut-off mentioned in Table 2. Candidates not meeting the criteria in Table-2 shall note that their applications may be considered for subsequent rounds of seat allotment against the vacant seats, if any, after the first offline Reporting/ Counseling is completed.

The following documents must be produced at the time of Reporting/ Counseling:

- Printed application form, filled by candidate through the SAMARTH portal.
- One set of self-attested photocopies of Aadhaar ID, Class 10th Certificate/ Mark sheet, Class 12th mark sheet, CUET (UG) 2025 Score Card, Certificate (if applicable) of OBC-NCL/ SC/ ST/ EWS/ Ex-Service Man/Dependent Freedom Fighter/ PwD category/ sub-category, NCC/ NSS certificate, etc., and all other relevant documents. OBC-NCL (in the format of Central Government) and EWS Certificates must be issued on or after 1st April, 2025.
- Original Transfer Certificate (TC) or Migration Certificate, Character Certificate (CC), Affidavit for the gap year period (if applicable), and Anti-Ragging Affidavit (as given in the University Prospectus 2025–26).
- Five (05) passport size photographs.

The counselling shall be strictly based on the normalized score (NTA Score) of CUET (UG)-2025 entrance test. If offered admission, the candidate has to take admission by 3:00 p.m. on 14th August, 2025, by filling up a prescribed Admission Form and by depositing tuition and other fees, failing which the allotted seat to him/her will be treated as cancelled. The candidates should note that this letter is only for offline Reporting/ Counseling, and it does not give any guarantee for admission. The admission will be subject to the availability of the seats in the respective categories and fulfilment of the eligibility criteria.

The tuition and others fee of the B. Tech. course is Rs. 28550/- approx. (Rupees Twenty Eight thousand five hundred and fifty only) per year. Candidates are advised to be prepared accordingly for deposition of fee at the time of counseling.

Note that the university has a limited hostel facility, and the university does not provide Hostel Accommodation to all the students admitted to above mentioned programs. To avail the hostel facility, the admitted students will have to apply separately and may contact the **office of the Chief Hostel Warden** (941232093). If the hostel seat is allotted, the students have to pay the fee and other charges of the hostel separately in addition to the fee of Rs. 28550/- stated above. For further details, the candidates are advised to go through the University prospectus and the website www.hnbgu.ac.in.

In view of the present weather/ road conditions of the region, the candidates are advised to arrive one day before the reporting date.

Important Notes:

- 1. If the candidate, who has been offered a seat in B. Tech Programme of his/her priority, does not deposit fees within due date and time, his/her candidature for all B. Tech Programmes will be treated as cancelled.
- 2. If the reported candidates in offline/Physical counselling have not been offered any seat for B. Tech Programme, their candidature for admission will be considered for subsequent counselling according to their filled preferences if the seat is vacant.
- 3. The branch will be upgraded for allotted and fees paid candidates according to their filled preferences and seat availability in the respective branch.
- 4. These admissions are strictly **PROVISIONAL** and will be confirmed only after physical verification of all relevant/required documents. In case of any discrepancy found later, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.
- 5. Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination from any recognized Board/University with Physics and Mathematics as a compulsory subject along with Chemistry/Computer Science/Electronics/ Information Technology/Biology/Informatics Practices/ Biotechnology obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together (Please refer page no 17 of University Prospectus (2025-26).
