c. Roles & Responsibilities

- Chief Hostel Warden and wardens will monitor all cleanliness drives in the hostels (Birla/Chauras).

- NCC units coordinate with mapping and clear Cleanliness Target Units (CTUs).
- Coordinators for Birla and Chauras Campus will document all the activities for institutional report.
- Media Cell will ensure coverage and social media outreach.
- Nodal officer and coordinators with the help of AR Finance, will prepare proposal to allocate contingency funds for sanitation materials, promotional banners, prize and refreshments.
- Collaboration with local municipal bodies for waste disposal and technical support.
- On Sep 25, 2025 the One day, One hour, togetherness program will be held at 8am.

This main cleaning campaign will be conducted at Chauras and Birla campus with the participation of teachers, students, non-teaching staff and in collaboration with the Nagar Nigam Srinagar and Nagar Panchayat Kirtinagar.
