Proceedings:

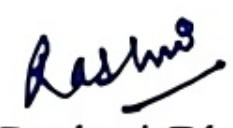

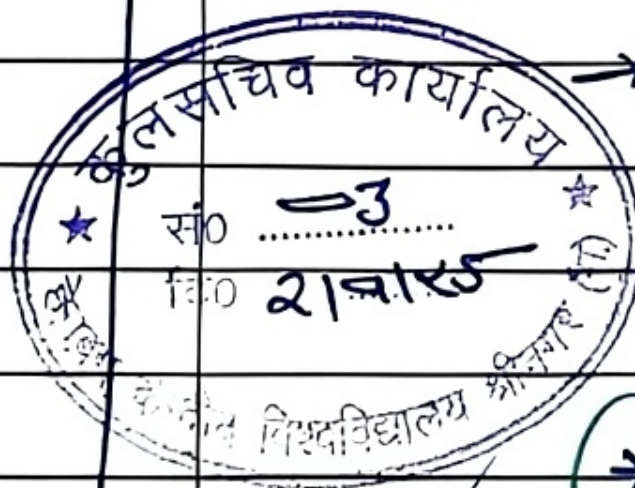
Honourable Vice Chancellor Sir,
